- » Increase the number of teachers achieving national certification at the Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher positions to leverage their expertise across the system
- » Expand the Leader Advisor program to strengthen induction and support of new site leaders
- Develop a network of Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people to sponsor and mentor other Aboriginal people into leadership
- » Map site-based leadership development pathways and implement support, including a strategic approach to middle leadership development
- » Design and deliver capability building programs to support emerging system reform


- » Increase the number of teachers achieving national certification at the Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher positions to leverage their expertise across the system
