RE Freedom of Information – Determination

I refer to your Freedom of Information application received by the Department for Education on 14 August 2019, seeking access to:

Details (including full business name) of all applications (successful and unsuccessful) that were received for the tendering of teacher training, that was contracted to University of Melbourne on 5 March 2019. (Excluding any commercial-in-confidence information).

Searches have been conducted for information in relation to your request. Four documents have been located that have been identified as matching the scope of your application.

Consultation was undertaken with the four respondents, for Part D of the bids, noting that the whole bid itself is commercial in confidence and therefore not within scope of your application.

I have considered the documents with reference to the *Freedom of Information Act, 1991* ("the FOI Act") and have determined to release all four documents in part.

I have determined that the documents contain personal information regarding someone other than yourself, which has been redacted. The disclosure has been determined as unreasonable, having regard to the likelihood that the person may not want that information disclosed. This information falls within the definition of personal affairs under the FOI Act, therefore is exempt by virtue of Schedule 1, clause 6(1) which provides that:-

6—Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) *A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).*

No costs have been levied for processing of your application as they are within the threshold prescribed by the Freedom of Information (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2018 allowed for Members of Parliament.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you are entitled to exercise your right for an internal review in accordance with section 29(1) of the FOI Act. To make an internal review application, please complete an application for Internal Review which can be downloaded from <https://www.education.sa.gov.au/department/legal-services/freedom-information-foi-requests>. Alternatively an application may be made in writing, addressed to the Principal Officer of this agency and must be accompanied with the appropriate fee (if applicable). This application must be lodged within 30 days from the date of this determination.


