The profile focuses on your skills and teaching practice; therefore you only need to complete the profile once. Once completed you can upload your profile to any jobs you wish to apply for.

Alongside your profile you'll also upload a positioning statement which will be tailored to the position you're applying for.

Your applicant profile and positioning statement will be used by school leaders as they undertake their selection processes.

All teaching positions will be advertised via Edjobs. As you progress through the application process, you'll be able to upload both your applicant profile and positioning.
