Your positioning statement is an opportunity for you to outline why you've chosen to apply for a position and how you'll impact the learning outcomes of students in the subject areas.

Your positioning statement is also an opportunity for you to describe the impact that you'll have on the school and its community.

You'll need to complete a positioning statement for each position you apply for. The positioning statement consist of 2 questions. Responses to each question are limited to 3000 characters.

When completing your positioning statement you should consider:

- What interests you about the subject area.
- What interests you about the school at which you are applying.

Once completed, you can upload your positioning statement alongside your **applicant profile** to any positions you apply for. All teaching position will be advertised on **Edujobs**.

Your positioning statement and applicant profile will then be used by school leaders as they undertake their selection processes.

Quick tips

- To apply for any teaching positions, you'll need to provide your **applicant profile** and positioning statement.
- Your positioning statement should be unique to each role that you apply for.
- There are 2 questions, each with a 3000 character limit.
 - » We suggest developing your responses in a Microsoft Word document which will allow you to monitor the character count.
- All teaching positions are advertised via **Edujobs**.
